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Open the download folder and double click on the DEVICENAME_config_file.mobileconfig file.

Click Continue "Are you sure you want to instal VEN-Configuration" popup window.

Click install on the next window.

Enter your Mac Admin Password.

When this window is displayed the VEN connection as been installed.

Close.

Then goto system Preferances and select Network.



Select the iQuila Client on the right and tick the "Show VPN status in menu bar"

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Click the Connect button and the iQuila Client will conect to your virtual switch.

To Disconnect just press Disconnect.
