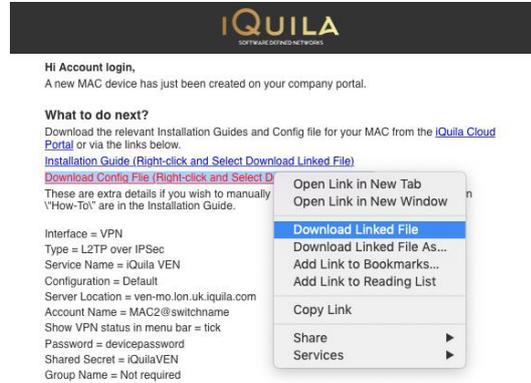

## **iQuila Guide** **to using the *mobileconfig* file on MacOS**

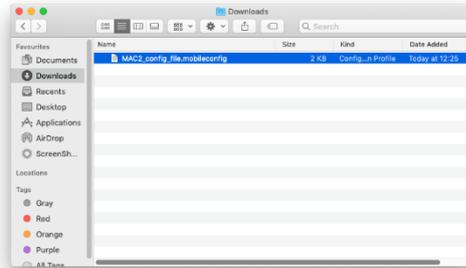
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# Guide to installing iQuila via the *mobileconfig* file in MacOS

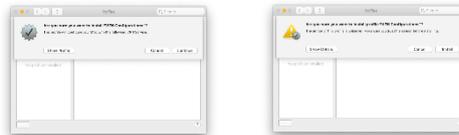
From your “New Device” email, download the config file to your Mac. Please take note with reference to “Right-Click and Select Download Linked File” as the the file will open instead of downloading.



Open the download folder and double click on the *DEVICENAME\_config\_file.mobileconfig* file.

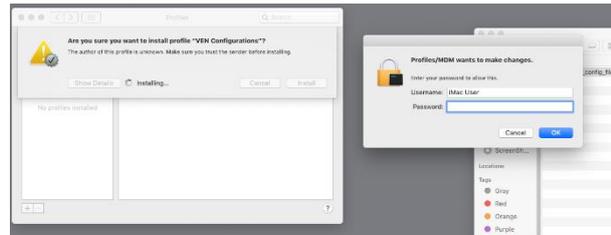


Click Continue “Are you sure you want to instal VEN-Configuration” popup window.



Click install on the next window.

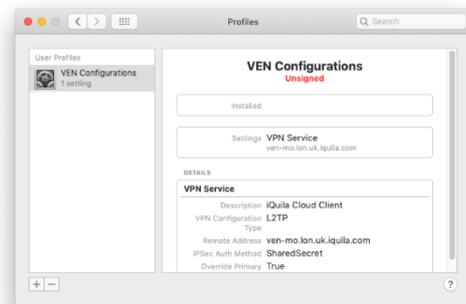
Enter your Mac Admin Password.



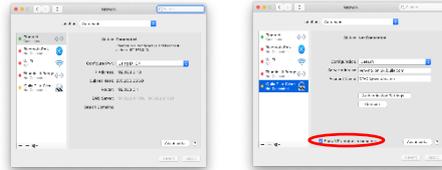
When this window is displayed the VEN connection as been installed.

Close.

Then goto system Preferences and select Network.



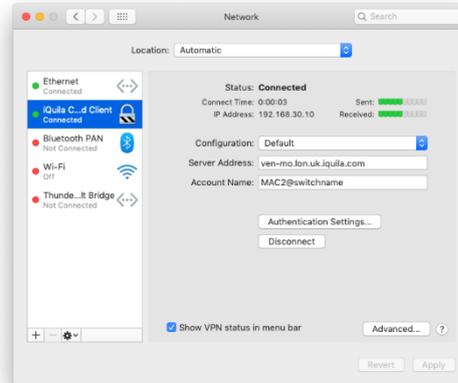
Select the iQuila Client on the right and tick the “Show VPN status in menu bar”



Click the Connect button and the iQuila Client will connect to your virtual switch.

To Disconnect just press Disconnect.

This is the manual connect/disconnect option of connecting to the iQuila Cloud. If you require the “Always-on” option, please create a new Mac device and select the “Always-On” option or download the files via the links below.

## To Uninstall this Installation. Please follow the steps below.

If you have opted for this type of installation, then iQuila would have installed the Cloud connection as a Profile.

Navigate to System Preferences and select the Profile option.



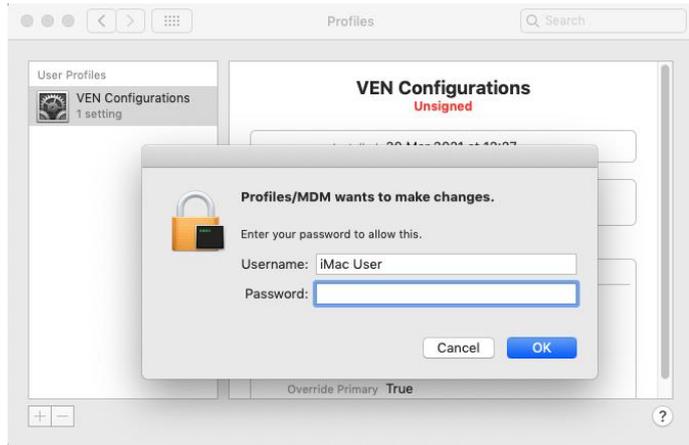
Select the – to delete the profile.
