
Installing the iQuila Cloud App for Android Devices.

Please scan the QR code, or go to the Google Play Store via the Play Store App on your Android Device. Type in the search bar **iQuila** and select the iQuila Cloud App.




Open the Play Store




Search for iQuila

Using iQuila with an account



If you have not yet created an Android device on the iQuila Cloud Portal please create one. Otherwise Select Sign in.



Enter the Password assigned to the device, the Switch Name assigned and the Country that the service is located in.



The App is now ready to connect to the iQuila VEN. Select Connect.



The App is now ready to connect to the iQuila VEN. Select Connect.



Select Disconnect to disconnect the App from the VEN Session.



The following details can be found on the email sent when the device was created. Enter the Device Name.



The following two settings are optional. **Enable Secure Internet.** Directs all data traffic out via the iQuila Cloud. **Enable AutoStart.** Allows the iQuila App to start automatically on the Android device.



Select Disconnect to disconnect the App from the VEN Session.




The App now shows that it is connected.



Re-enter the Device name and Password to sign into the App. Or re-run the wizard to re-enter new device details.

Advance Settings.



For advance settings, go to your Android device Network and Internet settings and select VPN.




There are three optional settings to chose from.



Block connections without VEN.

will block all data traffic from connecting to the internet until the iQuila VEN connection is restarted.



Select the gear icon to enter advance settings.



Always on VEN. Allows the App to re-connect to the VEN session when connection is lost.



Forget VEN.

This will delete the VEN connection.
